The growing interest in the development of compilers for other computers called for a consolidation of Pascal, and two years of experience in the use of the language dictated a few revisions. This led in 1973 to the publication of a Revised Report and a definition of a language representation in terms of the ISO character set. The Manual is directed to those who have previously acquired some familiarity with computer programming, and who wish to get acquainted with the language Pascal. It defines standard Pascal which constitutes a common base between various implementations of the language.
