It is simple: since fulfilling the great commission is such an important mandate, it is natural that Satan would do everything to oppose it. Satan's #1 strategy for opposing the great commission through discipleship in cell groups, is to convince churches that it is sufficient to speak of it occasionally, and expect that it will happen spontaneously without embracing it as the #1 priority. This manual addresses the need for each church to become a church of overcomers and not merely a community of saved people. This first course is designed to help believers see that the great commission is not an impossible task. On

the contrary, it can be fulfilled in just a few years. In these four sessions you will begin to understand that reaching the world for Christ can be accomplished in a single generation. After successfully completing this course, there should be an intense desire to complete the other three.

COURSE TWO: AN APPROACH TO EVANGELISMIn this six session experience the student will learn the information one needs to understand in order to introduce someone to Christ and how to present the five initial discipleship steps, one on one, in order to help the new believer begin a walk with God. This is the 'how to' portion of evangelism training. Introducing people to Christ is not difficult; any believer can learn to do it!

COURSE THREE: ATTITUDES MAKE A DIFFERENCEIn this study we look at the nine attitudes Jesus shared at the very beginning of His training in Matthew 5. These nine attitudes (Beatitudes) are the very first recorded lessons from the Savior when He gathered His disciples around Him, after He saw the multitudes He loved (Matthew 5:1). Attitudes are important because they set the atmosphere for successful communication. Through this course the student is constantly challenged to evaluate just how each attitude can enhance his/her effectiveness in sharing the good news of the Gospel. The focus in this course is holiness, the Christian life and obedience to Christ.

COURSE FOUR: FROM CONVERT TO DISCIPLE The information in this course is vital to completing the "Great Commission." Too often when an individual accepts Christ as Savior we rejoice (which we should), put them in a place where they can learn to 'live the life' and consider them to be a 'disciple'. This course begins by defining the word 'disciple' to mean what Jesus meant for it to mean when He gave His instructions in Matthew 28:19-20. When we make a 'convert' we only add to the church. When we teach the convert to lead others to Christ and then to teach the 'others' to do the same we multiply and after completing courses one, two and three, the student will have a clear understanding of the difference! Upon completing the four courses the student should be ready to teach the material to others and is ready to introduce another to Christ, form a small group and with the help of the church, lead three or more new people into becoming true disciples, ready to reach others for the Lord, thus beginning the multiplication process!

The Matthew Journey: A Discipleship Manual Through the Gospel of Matthew Aug 18 2022 Before Jesus left his disciples he gave them the famous commission to "Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything that I've commanded you..." (Mt 28:19-20). The commission actually reveals a unique characteristic of Matthew's Gospel - it was designed to be a training manual for the Matthean community of disciples. Matthew's Gospel was structured along five major discourses on discipleship (Ch's 5-7; 10; 13; 18; 24-25). In addition to these formalized sermons, the gospel contains numerous situational teaching moments. Thus, future disciples are expected to assimilate the entire spectrum of Jesus' teaching content found in both His preaching and practice. The disciple of Jesus should know: - who Jesus is - what Jesus has to say,

and - what Jesus did. Knowing who he is will inspire faith in him. Knowing what he commands will guide the disciple in obedience, and knowing what the Master does will provide a pattern to follow. These three lines of inquiry will guide the disciple's development into the image of Jesus. The end-game in following such a manual is that the believer will be prepared to make disciples of others. If this all sounds to you like a pretty tall order, well then you're right. It is a demanding journey! Welcome to The Matthew Journey. This study guide follows the course taught at Eastpoint Church in Spokane Valley, WA. It is designed to be a thirteen week discipleship/mentoring curriculum for committed disciples.

The Bible is the text for the study and the study manual will guide group members in their study and preparation for the weekly group session. The study manual also includes suggestions for individual research and study-related activities. Space is provided for taking notes while reading Scripture, for recording thoughts and questions arising out of daily study, and for notes during the weekly group session. The titles of the sessions along with theme words and theme verses, and major persons, events, and topics will set the sequence of the biblical story in the minds of the participants. The principal Scripture for each session follows the chronological movement of the biblical story. Disciple III Remember Who You Are is the third study in the four-phase DISCIPLE program. The driving idea in this study is the connection between memory and identity as the people of God. The word You in the title is meant to be heard both in its singular form (the individual) and its plural form (the community). We are a community of memory. Participants in this 32 week study will read the major and minor Old Testament prophets, with the exception of Daniel, and will read the thirteen Letters traditionally attributed to Paul. To establish the historical context in which the prophets spoke for God, daily reading assignments draw also on the books of Deuteronomy through Chronicles. Several themes weave their way through the study – the call to remember; the call to repentance; the need for renewed vision; and the place of community. The prophets and Paul are

continually calling hearers and readers back to their God and to a sense of who they are as a people "set apart." The Christian Faith is about being born again. It is about confession and receiving forgiveness for your sins. It is about becoming a child of God. It is about becoming part of the family of God as His son and daughter. It is about becoming a citizen of the Kingdom of God. It is about being restored, finding your purpose in life, and ultimately finding and fulfilling God's purpose for your life. This course is a field-tested Discipleship Course, tested and developed over a 30 year period and now used in churches in over 70 nations. This Discipleship Course is designed to help people give their lives to the Lord, or, for those who made a decision for Christ but never put down roots for their faith grow, to affirm their faith in Jesus and finally to put down roots and grow to maturity in Christ. Whichever one you might be, I pray that the Lord would use this material to guide you to an enriching experience with living in fellowship and on purpose for God. This course is built on the Bible and therefore you will find a lot of Scriptures in it. This journey is made up of a few phases. It is called a Discipleship journey from which you will benefit most if you follow them through systematically from Step One to Step Five. This course will take you at least One Year to complete, however, as with living trees, it takes a lifetime to grow into a mighty tree. By daily drawing sap through our spiritual roots, being firmly grounded in the Word, prayer and in Fellowship, we will grow slowly and steadily.

DISCIPLESHIP ONE - SALVATION The first phase of discipleship deals with the germination of our seed of faith. This phase deals with the essentials, or elementary applications of putting our faith in Jesus Christ as Lord.

DISCIPLESHIP TWO - ESTABLISHING ROOTS, VALUES AND DISCIPLINES The second phase deals with establishing roots from which our faith will grow and mature. Instilling the Values of the Kingdom of God develops our spiritual roots. We develop spiritual disciplines to keep and maintain these values in our lives.

DISCIPLESHIP THREE - DEVELOPING GIFTS AND SKILLS The third phase of Discipleship deals with discovering and developing our spiritual gifts. It is the time when we develop ministry skills to fulfil our calling in service of the Lord and we continue to grow strong and healthy roots to ensure that we,

both bring forth healthy fruit, as well as, withstand the evil temptation of the enemy.

DISCIPLESHIP FOUR - FRUITFULNESSThe fourth phase of Discipleship deals with us bearing Fruit through consistently putting into practice what we've learnt, by living a life of love, that is worth following, and shepherding those entrusted to our care.

DISCIPLESHIP FIVE - MULTIPLICATIONThe fifth phase of Discipleship deals with our Disciples multiplying themselves through their Disciples, by helping and guiding them to consistently put into practice what they've learnt, and to help their Disciples to do the same. We model it to them by living a life of love, that remains worth following, and shepherding them into their purpose.
